Dear concert visitor,

In order to ensure a pleasant evening at the concert and a smooth entrance, we ask you to carefully read and observe the points listed below. Please pay particular attention to the **Arrival Info (see page 3)**, since very few parking options are available. The motto here is: “trust in public transport”. All Rammstein concert-goers should leave their cars at home and travel by public transport to Cannstatter Wasen.

All concert tickets are “VVS-Kombikarten”, which means that the use of public transport in the Stuttgart region / the VVS transport region is included in the price of the ticket

For your own protection and that of all other visitors, we **recommend** that you voluntarily take a quick test before attending the event. There are no testing facilities on site.

If you feel ill or even have symptoms that indicate a Covid-19 disease, please stay at home!

Generally speaking, there are no longer any corona restrictions, but it is still recommended that masks be worn.

PERSONALIZED TICKETS

All tickets were sold personalized. This means that all tickets must show the name of the ticket holder. The ticket can be re-personalized or passed on via the Eventim customer account of the ticket buyer up to 24 hours before the start of the event via the "sell" button on the order. Alternatively, you can also go directly to www.fansale.de.

In exceptional cases, re-personalization will also be possible on showday at the fairground provided that the original ID document of the original ticket holder is available. Powers of attorney are not accepted. Please note that there may be considerable waiting times for new personalization on site. Please plan this when you arrive.

Important: Admission is only possible with a new e-ticket with the current show date of 2022. All previous tickets are no longer valid and do not entitle you to admission. The new tickets have been available for download in your account since the end of April 2021.

Tickets for the Mercedes-Benz Arena are no longer valid.

SECURITY RESTRICTIONS

For security reasons, visitors are not permitted to bring glass bottles, cans, rigid packaging or other items that could be used as projectiles (e.g. deodorants, perfume, etc.) onto the premises. Such items will therefore be confiscated at entry.

Bags only up to max. DIN A4 (21cm x 29.7cm)

This ban concerns bags and backpacks whose largest side is bigger than the "A4" format (21.0 x 29.7 cm).

To minimise waiting times at entry, we ask all concert-goers to refrain from bringing bags in general. If this is not an option, it is possible to deposit such items on site with the baggage storage points set up for this purpose.

Smaller bags (bum-bags, small handbags, clutches) can be taken in, but we ask you nevertheless to keep belongings to an absolute minimum (e.g. money, medications).

We therefore ask you to leave the following items at home to ensure entry is as speedy as possible:

- Large bags such as backpacks, shopping bags, travel bags, suitcases, baskets and cooler bags
- Professional cameras with interchangeable and/or zoom lens and video function
- Any kind of audio and video recording device
- Lighting and video equipment
- GoPro cameras

- Selfie-sticks
- Electronic devices such as tablets, laptops, power banks, **with the exception of mobile phones**
- Food and drink (one Tetra-Pak of up to 0.5 litres is allowed per person as long as these have not been opened and are non-alcoholic). A wide range of food and drinks is available on site.
- Stools (no walking frames are allowed inside the concert venue)
- Weapons, knives, tasers, batons, pepper spray, etc.
- Glass containers
- Torches, key or wallet chains, glowsticks, laser pointers
- Large flags and posters (including poles)
- Helmets

Please also comply with the Cannstatter Wasen rules of conduct!

OTHER INFO

You will find a wide range of food and drink stands throughout the premises and also inside the concert venue. In your own interest and for security reasons, only one Tetra-pak or PET bottle (max. 0.5 litre – non-alcoholic and unopened) per person may be taken into the concert grounds.

Only cash payment accepted.

Don't forget about sun protection (cream, head wear, etc.) and rain-proof clothing.

Loud music can damage your hearing! We would like to remind visitors, children in particular, to wear ear-protection and stand at an appropriate distance away from speakers. Children under 6 years of age are not permitted to enter.

First-aiders and doctors are on site for medical emergencies.

ARRIVAL

The motto is “trust in public transport”. All Rammstein concert-goers should leave their cars at home and travel by public transport to the Cannstatter Wasen.

ARRIVING BY CAR

Very few parking options available.

Visitors arriving from outside the city by car are asked to use the signposted Park & Ride car parks (an overview of the Park & Ride options can be found at <http://www.vvs.de/>) or other appropriate parking spots in Stuttgart or to drive in to a city train station.

ARRIVING BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT

All concert tickets are “VVS-Kombikarten”, which means that the use of public transport in the Stuttgart region / the VVS transport region is included in the price of the ticket.

Stadtbahn underground:

The special U11 line has trains every 7 to 8 mins from the city centre (Hauptbahnhof–Berliner Platz–Charlottenplatz) to Cannstatter Wasen (Neckarpark / Stadion) and in a greater frequency from the Wasen to the city centre after the end of the concert.

The U19 has trains to Cannstatter Wasen (Neckarpark / Stadion) via Bad Cannstatt until 8 pm

S-Bahn urban rail:

Destination station is Stuttgart Bad Cannstatt, from there on foot to Cannstatter Wasen.

(Alternatively Stuttgart Hbf, and then further with the S-Bahn or Stadtbahn special line U11)

The following S-Bahn lines can be used:

- **S1** Herrenberg – Kirchheim (Teck) as well as **S13** Kirchheim (Teck) – Flughafen/Messe, both every 30 minutes, or every 15 minutes between the Schwabstraße and Plochingen stops.
- **S2** Filderstadt – Schorndorf as well as **S21** Schorndorf – Herrenberg, both every 30 minutes.
- **S3** Flughafen/Messe – Backnang as well as **S32** Backnang – Filderstadt, both every 30 minutes.
- **S4** Backnang – Marbach and Marbach – Schwabstraße every 30 minutes, changing train in Marbach is required.
- **S5** Bietigheim – Schwabstraße every 30 minutes.
- **S6/60** Weil der Stadt/Böblingen – Zuffenhausen every 15 minutes, from Zuffenhausen further with the S4.

(the lines S1, S2, S3 will take you directly to Bahnhof Stuttgart Bad Cannstatt; with lines S4, S5, S6, you will have to change in Stuttgart Hbf)

Regional transport:

You can use the following regional trains:

- From direction of Pforzheim/Mühlacker: IRE1 Karlsruhe-Stuttgart is being redirected to Esslingen via Ludwigsburg. Change in Esslingen to the S-Bahn. The RB17 (Pforzheim/Bruchsal-Stuttgart) ends in Bietigheim.
- From direction of Ulm: RE5 Lindau-Ulm-Stuttgart every 60 minutes. Change in Esslingen to the S-Bahn. MEX16 (Ulm -) Geislingen–Stuttgart, twice an hour to Bad Cannstatt.
- From direction of Heilbronn: due to maintenance work, the lines RE8 between Würzburg and Neckarsulm, RB18 between Osterburken and Heilbronn and RE12 between Heilbronn and Stuttgart are closed. Also, the RE8 line ends in Bietigheim. Travelling further is possible only with the S-Bahn, changing at Hauptbahnhof Stuttgart to Bad Cannstatt. The RB18 travels via Ludwigsburg and Esslingen to Tübingen. Change in Esslingen to the S-Bahn.
- From the direction of Tübingen: every hour with RE12 (Tübingen–Stuttgart) to Bad Cannstatt and hourly with RB18 (Tübingen–Heilbronn) to Esslingen and further with the S-Bahn.
- From direction of Gaildorf: RE90 (Nürnberg–Stuttgart, every 2 hours) and MEX19 (Gaildorf–Stuttgart), every 30 minutes to Bad Cannstatt.
- From direction of Aalen: MEX13 (Crailsheim–Aalen–Stuttgart) every 30 minutes to

Bad Cannstatt.

- From direction of Horb: RB14 every two hours (with train section from Freudenstadt) as well as every 2 hours with the IC (on the Gäubahn, IC can be used with local transport tickets).

Travel away from the concert is as above: the S-Bahn lines have trains every 30 minutes, regional transport trains hourly.
